




**Acceptable forms of Identification for PROOF OF IDENTITY PURPOSES**

**EITHER:** A **National Student Number (NSN)**. The number must be stated on the Training Agreement and all names, date of birth and residency status must match.


**OR:** An original copy of a **Current NZ passport**




**OR:** An original copy of a **NZ Birth Certificate**  
*(if issued or reissued **after 2003\***)*


**A certified copy of a current International Passport**



**A certified copy of a NZ birth Certificate**  
*(if issued or reissued **before 2003\***)*



**A certified copy of an International Birth Certificate**



If your name on your Training Agreement does not match the name on the above IDs.

Please provide one of the supporting documents below to show your legal name change.

- Certified copy of Marriage Certificate (NZ or International)
- Certified copy of Civil Union Certificate
